Dear Parents/Carers.

Hopefully, we shall have lots of fabulous weather this summer term, so please remember to keep your child safe in the sun. We encourage all of the children to have their own water bottle (which they can fill up in the classroom), as well as having their own named sun hat to wear. If the weather is going to be hot, in the past, parents have put all-day sun cream on their child before coming to school, - therefore only needing one application.

We hope the children can use the field as much as they did last year; however, there is very limited shade around the field itself. The children can use the shade and shelters to sit in if they wish.

Attendance

Attendance last term was just below national average at 95% (national is 96%). Thank you to those of you who ensure that your child attends school regularly. Children who have had 100% in the Spring Term will receive a certificate.

If your child is absent for any reason, please inform the school office. For safeguarding purposes, school are obliged to contact parents if we have not received notification of a child's absence. In the first instance this is by ParentMail. Please respond to the texts as soon as possible.

Important notice

Could we please urge parents to regularly monitor their child's use of their mobile phones and other devices. It has recently come to school's attention that some children who have access to WhatsApp, Instagram, and other social groups/media sites have become involved in incidents which have resulted in malicious and inappropriate messages being posted about individuals. As you can imagine, this causes a great deal of distress to the child/children involved and their families. We acknowledge that what can often start as innocent 'postings' can often spiral out of control very quickly. As we have observed, this can then affect behaviour and relationships between the children in school.

Last half term, PCSO Luke Carson provided workshops for all classes from years 3-6, which raised an awareness of online safety and the causes and impact of cyberbullying. Our children are still very young and although we do our best to educate them of the possible disadvantages to having access to a range of apps, we cannot regulate what happens when the children are out of school. Parental support with this is essential.

Mrs. Keighley delivered an assembly this week to reinforce to the children that any type of bullying in school is unacceptable. Teachers will continue to address this in their PHSE lessons this term.

This week saw the completion of a new outdoor classroom to our Reception classes. It should provide additional learning areas for our youngest children even when our British weather is at its worst!
