Year 6 SATs

Congratulations to our Year 6 pupils who have successfully completed their End of Key Stage Assessments (SATs) this week. We are all incredibly proud of their hard work and wish them all the very best. Results usually arrive during the second week in July and the children will be notified of the outcomes by school during that week.

Attendance

This week, school has received a significant number of requests for authorisation for holidays in term time. Whilst school appreciates that the cost of holidays is cheaper for families at this time, school cannot authorise these periods of absenteeism as we are held to account for attendance by both the Local Authority and the Department for Education. The National average figures for attendance is 96%. The overall % to date (from September to April) is 95.7% which, although is only slightly below, is an indicator that we are below national percentages at this present time. Attendance, like pupil outcomes, is an indicator of how well the school is performing overall. School regularly notifies the parents of pupils who have poor attendance to ensure that the high expectations that we have at Blakehill are maintained.
