| Autumn Term 1 | Recognise quantities, without counting, to 5. (Subitise) |
| Autumn Term 2 | Name numbers in order to 10 and compare two numbers by saying which is more or less. |
| Spring Term 1 | Say 1 more than a given number up to 10. |
| Spring Term 2 | Partition numbers to 5 into two groups. Number bonds to 5. |
| Summer Term 1 | Partition numbers to 10 into two groups. Begin to know number bonds to 10. Know some odd and even numbers to 10. |
| Summer Term 2 | Recite the number names in order to 30 and beyond. Automatically recall double facts up to 5 + 5. |

KIRFs

Key Instant Recall Facts

support the development of the mental skills that underpin much of the maths work in schools.

They are particularly useful when calculating, be it adding, subtracting, multiplying or dividing.
