#### Staff news

Members of the Senior Leadership Team, our school Learning mentor and other members of staff are always visible at the beginning and the end of the school day should you need to speak to someone.

## Reception

We are extremely pleased at how well our new children have settled into school in the Reception classes. They are adapting quickly to the routines and are already demonstrating really positive attitudes to learning. Photos of the children's first week will be posted on our school blog on Friday. Thank you to the parents of these children for helping us to make sure that transition has been as smooth and enjoyable as possible.

## **Holiday Building Work**

You may have noticed that the steps leading from the top playground to the Year 1 and 2 playground have been widened to allow easier access for parents and pupils. This came as a result of feedback from parents who had concerns regarding congestion caused by the main gate being closed in the mornings. This appears to have eased the congestion.

Parents should have received an email earlier this week to inform you that the main gate, opposite the school office will be open from 3pm daily to allow access to school via Reception class playground.

There has been an additional security gate installed for families that use the service provided by Extra Club.

For your child's safety, the school gates are locked at 9:00am and reopen at 3:00pm. Entrance to school can be accessed via the main entrance on Highfield Road.

## **Contact Telephone Numbers**

It is important that the school office have current and correct contact details of parents / carers, in particular mobile and telephone numbers which are especially vital when children are ill and contact needs to be made. Could you please ensure that our office staff are notified if you have changed address or telephone numbers.

## Picking Up Your Child at the End of the School Day

If you change arrangements for picking up your child at the end of the school day, please ensure you inform school to avoid any confusion at home times.













#### **Polite Reminders**

Our school handbook states that jewellery, make up and nail varnish should not be worn in school by our children and those pupils with pierced ears are allowed to wear studs only. Watches can be worn and consideration is given to jewellery pertaining to religious and cultural beliefs.

#### **Mobile Phones**

Mobile phones are not encouraged to be brought to school by pupils. In exceptional circumstances there may be no alternative, but they **must** be **switched off** on entering the school grounds and then handed to the class support staff for safe keeping during the day. Pupils must not use them inside the school grounds.

## School Attendance 2017-2018

Last year, pupil attendance was **95.3%** which is slightly below the **96%** national average. Thank you to parents for ensuring that their child's/ren's attendance is consistently good throughout the year. In an attempt to work together to ensure pupils attend school as regularly as possible, we are sending your child home with an **Attendance Home/School Agreement** which outlines Blakehill's commitment to attendance. We are asking staff, pupils and parents to sign the agreement to demonstrate their commitment and return it to school by **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September**. Thank you.

We are well aware that holidays are cheaper during term time however we do urge that children are not taken on holiday during these times as attendance can affect a child's attainment and progress. All requests for holidays will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. Attendance will be continued to be monitored throughout the school.

## **Parking**

There has been a massive improvement in the consideration taken when dropping/collecting children in relation to parking. Thank you to all parents who make a concerted effort to consider the safety of our children and respect the impact that parking has on the local residents with regards to parking across driveways.

## **School Uniform**

The children have made a great start to the year and looked very smart in their new school uniforms.
