Year 3 Leeds Discovery Museum

Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our history topic on the Ancient Egyptians, we will be visiting the Discovery Museum on Thursday 28th February.

Each class will have the opportunity to explore the exhibits in the museum and will work with their group to explore key aspects of their topic. In addition, they will complete an Ancient Egyptians workshop where they will explore the main question 'how do we know about the Ancient Egyptians?' They will look at some of the things that were left behind and are now on display including a mummy, a coffin, prosthetic limbs, canopic jars, amulets, shabti and jewellery. These activities will allow the children to practise key history skills of looking at and learning from artefacts as well as participate in arts and crafts, making their own amulet and embalming their own Egyptian doll.

The cost of the visit, which includes a coach with seatbelts and workshops linked to our topic, is £6.50.
