Dear Parents/Carers,

The Rainbow Factory Visit – Traditional Tales

As part of our work on Traditional Tales, we have arranged for the Rainbow Factory to visit Blakehill to work with all the children in Reception for a day on Tuesday 27th April 2021.

The focus of this visit is to support children's understanding of difficult themes in a safe, fun and humorous way. Topics are gently dealt with through age appropriate discussion, positive thought practices and calming meditation techniques.

There will be an interactive performance of Jack and the Beanstalk, which will be uncovered in a theatrical, fun and adventure packed way.

The cost for the whole day is £9.70 per child. This cost includes two members of the Rainbow Factory staff, all props and assets for the show plus all the resources for the various workshops.

However, we must point out that if insufficient voluntary contributions are made then the visit may have to be cancelled.
