School Uniform

What a child wears to school reflects their attitude to learning; it portrays the school's ethos and shared values. At Blakehill, we have a very simple uniform that pupils are encouraged to wear. White / sky blue polo shirt,

- Black / grey trousers, shirt, dress or shalwar kameez,
- Navy blue sweatshirt, preferably with school logo
- Black shoes –not trainers
- Dark/ white socks/ tights

Trainers can be worn only for break times and PE but black shoes/pumps worn in school.

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name. This makes it easier when trying to locate lost property.

Parking

Could we remind parents to park with consideration when dropping off/ picking children up at the beginning and end of the school day.

We realise that parking availability is not ideal around the school premises but ask that you put our children's safety first.

School have already received a complaint from The Highfield Restaurant and Bar who, whilst currently allow parents to park in some areas of their private car park, are concerned that parents are parking across the entrance areas, making access dangerous. Our local PCSO has been alerted to these concerns.

Local residents have also requested that parents are mindful of access to residential driveways.
