Dear parents,

As part of our PHSCE curriculum, Year 6 will be visiting Blackpool Pleasure Beach on Friday 12th October 2018. This exciting trip will allow our children to face new challenges and provide opportunities for children to act in a mature way with independence and self-confidence.

Children should arrive at school at 8.15am on the morning of our visit to allow us to leave school at 8.30am. The children will return to school for 7.00 p.m.

The cost of the trip is £21, which includes return coach travel and park wristbands for Blackpool Pleasure Beach. **Payment and online consent forms can be submitted through Parentpay**, or alternatively payment and paper consent forms can be sent directly to the School Office.

There is no obligation upon you to contribute and your child will not be treated differently whether you contribute or not. However, I must point out that if insufficient voluntary contributions are made then the visit may have to be cancelled. If you are experiencing any financial hardship at this time and are unable to make a voluntary contribution, please do come and discuss the matter, in confidence, with the School Business Manager.

If you would like to be considered as a helper on the trip, please contact one of the year 6 team.

As we are away from school all day, children will need to bring a packed lunch ***in a named, disposable carrier-bag*** with a drink (**no glass bottles, fizzy drinks sweets or yoghurts please**). Alternatively, a packed lunch may be ordered from the school kitchen at the same cost as a school meal. All requests for packed lunches should be made through the school office by Monday 8th October 2018. *If your child is entitled to free school meals, a free packed lunch can be ordered through the School Meals Service.*

Children do not need to wear school uniform for our visit to Blackpool but please ensure they have weather appropriate clothing (it tends to cold later on in the afternoon!) and footwear. Children may also bring £5 spending money to spend in the gift shop or on additional refreshments.
